Bangalore: Hotmail co-founder Sabeer Bhatia has announced his plans to re-launch his travel portal Arzoo.com within in three months.

Bhatia, who floated a new venture 'Blogeverywhere.com' on Monday, said he was planning to relaunch Arzoo.com within three months time, but gave no further details.
